With the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister, General Administration Department is authorized to declare 2(two) local Holidays for Kamrup (M) District.
- 8. General Administration Department is allowed to declare 2 (two) additional holidays with the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam.
- 9. These Holidays will not be automatically applicable to the Educational Institutions, Medical/Engineering Colleges unless they adopt the list but it is desirable that the number of holidays may be decreased for Educational Institutions, Medical/Engineering Colleges etc. and they will adopt academic calendars decreasing the number of holidays.
